Yannick Chastang merges modern utility and ornate nostalgia

Ghosts live on in shadows of the past

objects observed when wandering through real European cities. Thus Nika Neelova offers casts of old London coal hole covers (which should attract a visit from Jeremy Corbyn) while Ken Sortais has latex moulds of a Paris Metro station entrance, looking a little like belle époque coquetry. Raphaël Barontini's banners and flags mixing popular and high art might be relics of a demonstration promoting the universality of culture.

Yannick Chastang is a highly regarded furniture restorer, specialising in marquetry, and in his *Shadows* he shows that there need be no division between art and craft. His installations give humdrum modern furnishings a lineage to a time of splendor and ceremony, by haunting a modern light fitting with the shadow of an ornate chandelier and a plain wooden chair with that of its 19th-century giltwood and cane forebear. Using ebony, sycamore and oak marquetry, he references a lost aristocratic taste of which only shadows remain. The ebony shadows are taken from objects at Waddesdon Manor.

Taisuké Mohri also deals with interiors, in a copy of a portrait of a boy by Greuze, which has a trompe-l'oeil of broken glass.

These works are not cheap. Chastang's *Shadows* are £16,000 for the chair and £8,000 for the chandelier, but unlike far more expensive installations by better known artists, their wit and craftsmanship could be enjoyed in a private home.

In two rooms, *A City without a Song*, the work of five artists curated by Karina El Hérou of the Parisian studiour/art (to February 27). They present an idea of a city and its past through moulds, casts and shadows of
